4. "Robert Natkin: And the Days Are Not Full Enough" at Hirschl & Adler Modern

This show traces the arc of painter Robert Natkin, a colorist who moved fluidly between improvisational expression and more defined geometrical compositions indebted to artists like <u>Paul Klee</u> and Mondrian. Describing him as the "author of a dabbled infinite," this thorough view of Natkin's work highlights the full range of his abilities in the Post-war art scene.
